

Amboy Community School District Remote Learning Plan

Grades and Student Work Guidelines

- All student work during the Remote Learning days will be graded as either a pass or an incomplete. Students will be given the opportunity to complete any incomplete work.
- Students should be expected to complete 1 hour of work per class/subject per week during this time.
- While paper resources will be continued to be made available, to reduce potential exposure to the virus, we are recommending as much as possible that grading of assignments and assessments be completed electronically. Anything that is sent from the home to the school will be essentially quarantined for a week before being delivered to the teacher.

Weekly Schedule

- Monday – Remote Learning Planning Day Teachers will be planning and in virtual faculty meetings on this day. No work will be assigned for Mondays.
- Tuesday – Teachers will be available from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm to both engage students in learning and for “office hours” to provide help to students and parents
- Wednesday – New weekly materials will be made available for pickup at Central between 10:30 am and 12:00pm and 5:00 pm and 6:00 pm and deliveries will be based on the delivery schedule. Teachers will be available from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm to both engage students in learning and for “office hours” to provide help to students and parents
- Thursday - Teachers will be available from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm to both engage students in learning and for “office hours” to provide help to students and parents
- Friday - Teachers will be available from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm to both engage students in learning and for “office hours” to provide help to students and parents

Weekly Lunch Schedule

Lunches will be provided on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays

Pickup is at Central from 11:00 am to 12:00 pm

Deliveries on the bus routes will be dependent upon the delivery schedule

Amboy High School

- Teachers Provide a technology-based platform for instruction
- Teachers need to be available via email from 9:00 – 2:00
- Lessons need to be available to students via a technology-based platform

Amboy Junior High School

- Teachers Provide a technology-based platform for instruction
- Teachers need to be available via email from 9:00 – 2:00

- Lessons need to be available to students via a technology-based platform.

Central Elementary School

- Teachers need to be available via email from 9:00 – 2:00
- Students should be expected to complete 5 hours of school work per week
- Instruction from home – Lessons will be sent home ahead of time

Staff Expectations

- Staff must be available by email from 9:00 – 2:00
- Must be at home or school
- Certified staff will check-in and out at the end of the day with their building principal via email.

Special Education Teachers

- Special Education and 504 students will be provided the same accommodations and modifications outlined in their IEP. Special education teachers will work with regular education staff to determine the appropriate modifications for any home-based learning materials.
- Special education teachers will contact families to determine the appropriate methods to supply help during the assigned work times.
- Help may be provided via email, school phones, and video conferencing

Education Support Staff

- Assignments may vary depending on the nature of duties.
- Paras, kitchen staff, bus drivers, and custodians can be offered the opportunity to make up the day by attending an upcoming in-service day or alternative working hours.

Return to In-person Instruction

Once the remote learning days have ended, we will then transition back to in-person instruction. Depending upon when this is, we will set a timeline and give students the opportunity to complete any incomplete work.
