


Letter of Understanding

July 15, 2023

It is mutually agreed between the District and the Union that beginning with the 2023 – 2024 school year the district will transition from 26 equal payments to 24 equal payments. The 2023 – 2024 school year will have 25 payments and 24 payments starting with the 2024 -2025 school year.

16.3 Method of Payment of Salary. The employees will receive their payment in 24 equal installments. If payday falls on a day the business office is closed, then the employees shall receive checks on the last day the business office is open prior to the regular pay day.

Letter of Understanding

Pay stipends for the person assuming the role of Head Cook of the District Lunch Program and Amboy High School Registrar.

It is mutual agreement that Amboy Community Unit School District # 272's employment of a Head Cook and Amboy High School Registrar is outside the scope of the Collective Bargaining Agreement Between Amboy CUSD # 272 Support Staff and Teamsters Local Union No, 722.

It is understood that payment for the performance of said duties of Head Cook and Amby High School Registrar shall be placed outside of the salary schedule as established in the Bargaining Agreement and, therefore, will be considered supplemental pay stipend. That stipend amount may be negotiated with each Bargaining Agreement renewal. The stipend will be for Head Cook \$6,153.95 and for the Amboy High School Registrar \$5,000.00 for each year of the Bargaining Agreement effective July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2026
