

DRAFT MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING
Between
Amboy Community Unit School District 272
And The
Amboy Education Association

Remote Teaching and Learning 2021-2022

The purpose of this memorandum is to memorialize the understanding reached between the Amboy Community Unit School District 272 Board of Education (“District”) and the Amboy Education Association (“AEA”) concerning the remote teaching and learning at all of the schools in the District as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

In the event that an entire classroom, AEA staff member and students, or an individual AEA staff member, are quarantined or asked to teach/learn remotely due to the recommendation from the Lee County Health Department and/or administrative decision for a COVID-19 reason, the following will occur:

- If the AEA member is vaccinated and asymptomatic, they will teach their class through Google Meet from their classroom.
- If the AEA member is quarantined, they will be offered the option to remote teach and teach their students remotely after the third day. If they choose to remote teach, they will not be charged sick leave time for the days they are remote teaching. The teacher must communicate the decision to remote teach by 3:00 on day 2 of the quarantine time frame. The staff member would work from home during their normal working hours. If the AEA staff member would choose not to remote teach, they would be charged sick leave time throughout the duration of their quarantine.
- Remote Instruction
 - a. Must be synchronous
 - b. Teachers will follow their building’s regular bell schedule for the day
 - c. Camera is on - background may be blurred
 - d. Teachers are readily available and interacting with students throughout the entire class period
 - e. Assignments and class materials will be provided ahead of the class time either digitally or paper copies provided
 - f. Teachers will arrange with their administrator to get the room ready for the day(s)
- The terms of this MOU shall remain in effect until any state of emergency due to COVID imposed by the Governor of the State of Illinois has been lifted.
